• Room #1 Printer is NOT completely out of ink. There are about 1000 copies left as of today. Learn to read the available number of copies.→→

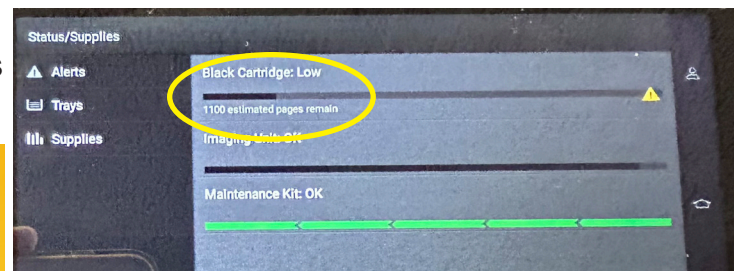
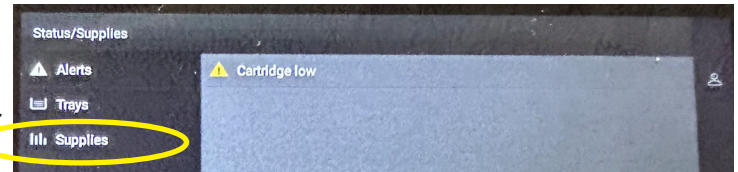
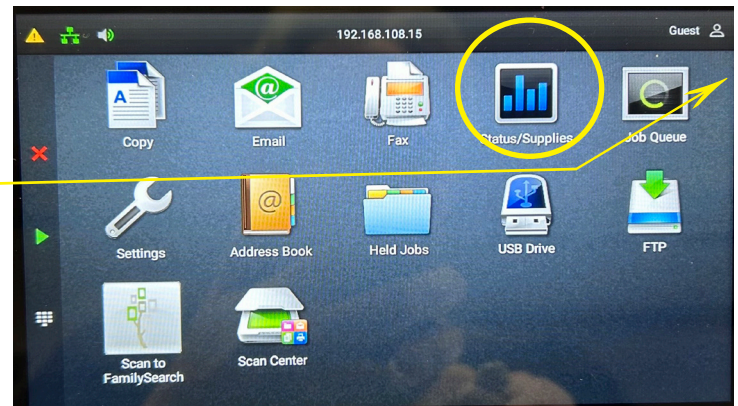
• If the touchscreen on the printer does not work, press the skinny white power button on the upper right hand side of the screen for five seconds to turn it off. Press again to tune on.
